

**SCHOOL Physicals** are required for ... 1<sup>st</sup> entry into school such as Pre-K and Kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> as well as out of state and in state transfers

- School physicals count as sports physicals, but ... a sports physical does not count as a school physical
- Physicals are due to the school office by the first day of school attendance
- Immunizations... are needed typically in K, 6<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and now 12<sup>th</sup>. This is also dependent on past vaccine history. Immunizations are due by the first day of attendance
- Eye exam ... is needed ... for all children enrolling in K or first time entry in any public or private school beyond K, (i.e. grades 1-12)
- Dental exam ... is needed ... by May of 2016 for grades 2<sup>nd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>
- Lead test ... is needed ... one lead test is needed prior to first entry to school such as Pre-K or K
